**Sound Workshop:**

Browns Mart is running a sound workshop as part of their 2018 Education Program in order to provide skills development to students interested, and / or already engaged in working backstage on theatre shows.

The Sound Designer is one of the most integral creative working on a Production Team. The music or score that a Sound Designer contributes vital sense of realism, mood and tension, as well as the appropriate sound effects required for the production.

The workshop will held in the Browns Mart Theatre, and be run by Browns Mart Production Manager Brad Fawcett. It will cover several topics and hands on practical elements including:

- The role of the sound designer
- How to set up a basic PA System
- Ideas on how to compile the soundtrack for a production.

We encourage students that have an interest in other areas of backstage theatre to take part in this workshop in order to get a broad understanding of theatrical process, and the role of people within production teams.

As the show workshops are linked to *The Crucible*, it is compulsory that students are booked to attend a performance if they wish to attend the workshop. Elements of the show will discussed in the workshop.
